How to Develop an Academic Plan

An academic plan is a *guide* for selecting courses each term. It is a map for helping get you to a university on *your timeframe*. The academic plan is not set in stone, but flexible to meet your academic needs.

Step 1	 Gather Materials. You will need Baccalaureate Degree Plan (BDP) for major at intended university. You can find BDP for the 16 UNC-System universities <u>here</u>. AA or AS Program - use the catalog or UTAC <u>checklist</u> Record of any Transfer or AP credits earned Record of credits earned at Southwestern Comm. College
Step 2	Determine required courses on BDP. Where do these requirements fit as part of your AA or AS?
Step 3	Make a list of the "have to" courses that you will take as part of your degree.
Step 4	When you have options for courses, such as a selection between four English literature courses, identify which courses you would prefer. Make a list of courses of interest you will take as part of your degree.
Step 5	What is your timeframe for transfer? Determine how long you plan to be at SCC, whether as a full-time or part-time student.
Step 6	Review <u>sample</u> academic plans on the UTAC webpage.
Step 7	Create your Academic Plan. On the <u>Academic Plan</u> sheet, fill in each semester with courses you plan to take. This sheet is a guide and can be adjusted at any time.
Step 8	Visit the UTAC. Meet with an academic advisor at the UTAC to review the academic plan you have created.
