

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
2001-2003


This Memorandum of agreement is between Mars Hill College, Mars Hill, North Carolina and Southwestern Community College, Sylva, North Carolina, and is for the purpose of establishing a system of transferring graduates of Southwestern Community College into specific academic programs at Mars Hill College.

Mars Hill College agrees to the following:

- I Graduates of Southwestern Community College who have completed the Associate of Arts degree in the College Transfer Program or the College Transfer Pre-Major Program will be admitted to Mars Hill College with junior standing and will have satisfied the Mars Hill College general education program
- II Transfer work for students who have not completed the college transfer program and for those students who have completed an Associate of Applied Science degree will be evaluated on a course-to-course basis. The Mars Hill College general education requirements and the Business Administration and Business Management course equivalencies are indicated on the attached equivalency listing.
- III All counseling of transfer students and approval of their transfer credits will be under the jurisdiction of the Registrar at Mars Hill College, in consultation with appropriate department chairpersons.
- IV Developmental or remedial courses will not be transferred with credit toward graduation. All Mars Hill College students, including transfer students, are subject to the college policies on developmental studies.
- V All community college courses which have been approved for college transfer will be accepted for credit (as requirements or electives) toward graduation. Technical courses will not be transferred with credit toward graduation.

Southwestern Community College agrees that all courses in the attached equivalency listings are taught by faculty with minimum credentials required by SACS


- VI Southwestern Community College and Mars Hill College jointly agree to the following:
  - A Adequate and continuing publicity concerning the nature of this agreement will be provided to the general public;
  - B Southwestern Community College agrees to inform students and graduates of the nature and provisions of this agreement.
- VII The President of Southwestern Community College and the Chancellor of Mars Hill College agree to appoint representatives from the two institutions to review the agreement on a continuing basis and to recommend changes.
- VIII This agreement will be effective upon approval and signature of the President of Southwestern Community College and the Chancellor of Mars Hill College.

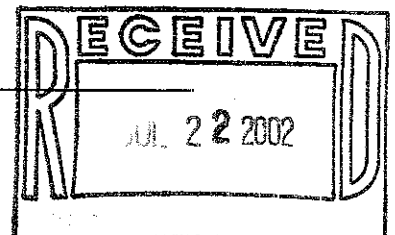
