T Watch your transfer credits (to core, or not to core?)

T Apply in a timely manner (application and scholarship deadlines)

Not all Universities have a "rolling" admissions process

Scholarship deadlines will fall somewhere between March 15-April 30 of each year

Check to see if your high school transcripts are needed

Submit SCC transcripts

health records ~ you must supply

T Don't Take Your Eye off of your Goal

Attend the University Open House

Attend the transfer orientation as soon as possible ~ current students have already registered

Expect a "good faith" deposit request to come quickly after acceptance

T Cautions

Acceptance to the University does not necessarily mean acceptance into a particular College
