CURRICULUM IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (CIP)

Curriculum Improvement Projects (CIP) were developed as a means of providing funding for system-wide projects in curriculum or instructional areas which are experiencing significant changes, such as job market developments, advances in technology, new teaching and delivery methods, and implementation of state or national educational initiatives. The projects are based on the belief that the classroom instructor is the critical factor in educational quality.

Professional development activities form the foundation for curriculum development and upgrading. Each project is required to provide professional development for instructors in content, methodology, and technology training. The two-year project should result in innovative instructional strategies that have a long-term, systemic impact in the targeted area.
