- **CPT / ASSET / COMPASS Test Scores are valid for 3 calendar years.** A student who has not started required developmental courses or who has scores older than 3 years will be required to retest, unless they placed and choose to remain in basic level of Developmental.
- **SAT-** SAT Math score accepted, SAT Writing or SAT Critical Reading scores will be accepted.
- **ACT** - Composite Score not accepted. ACT sub scores for English, Reading and Math are accepted.
- A student taking ENG 085, must also take ENG 090 & RED 090 or ENG 095 BEFORE taking ENG 111.
