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

Student Support Services (SSS) is Southwestern Community College's premiere student retention program helping students achieve their goal of graduating from SCC and/or transferring to a 4-year institution. Support to effectively manage all aspects of college life is provided *FREE* of charge to students who meet eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY

Student Support Services is a voluntary program available to eligible students demonstrating a need for academic support who are striving to achieve their goals of graduating or transferring.

To be eligible for SSS, a student must meet **ONE** of the following criteria:

- Be a first-generation college student
 (parents or quardians do not have a bachelor's degree)
- Meet income eligibility requirements
- Have a documented disability



SERVICES

- Academic Co-Advising: Each student works with an SSS advisor who supports their success at SCC.
- Personal Development: Programs are offered to help students develop financial literacy, apply for scholarships, and prepare to succeed while in college and after graduation.
- Tutoring: SSS students receive extra hours of free tutoring in addition to the hours SCC provides for all students.
- Transfer Services: The SSS transfer advisor provides assistance in exploring 4-year college options, applying, and scheduling campus visits.
- Scholarship & Grant Support: Supplemental Grant Aid and program scholarships are available only to SSS participants. These awards are competitive and require an application to be considered.
- Resource Loan Program: Laptops, calculators, books, and personal development DVDs are available on loan for program participants.
- Enrichment Activities: Opportunities to make new friends and experience the unique culture and environment of Western North Carolina are offered each semester including hikes, whitewater rafting, geocaching and visits to the Biltmore House during the holidays.
