	Participants were evenly divided in rating student/graduate preparation for employment or further education as prepared and very prepared. None of the participants gave a rating below prepared.
	Follow Up Question: Why did you select the answer that you did?
	Some participants indicated they selected Prepared because graduates need on the job experience to become proficient in their profession.
	Another participant indicated some graduates become overly dependent upon the level of support they receive at SCC and must adapt when this support is not available at the place of employment or at a four-year university.
2.	If you know of individuals or groups who have not attended SCC, explain why.
	Some continue to view community colleges as being inferior to a four-year university; also counselors in private schools strongly encourage students to continue their education at a four-year institution.
	Older adults are sometimes intimidated at the prospect of entering college
	Travel distance
	Lack of student housing
	Lack of affordable/available childcare
	Individuals with a background of academic failure lack the confidence to enroll at SCC

Some individuals perceive programs at SCC as too rigorous- prefer to go elsewhere where academic standards are perceived as less demanding
