

Articulation Agreement
Southwestern Community College Early Childhood Associate and Western
Carolina University Bachelor of Science in Birth-Kindergarten (teacher licensure).

This articulation agreement between Southwestern Community College and Western Carolina University allows graduates of the SCC Early Childhood Associate program to transfer credit towards a Bachelor of Science in Birth-Kindergarten (teacher licensure). A minimum of 32 semester hours of upper level course credit, including 12 semester hours in the major field need to be completed at Western to earn the B-K (teacher licensure) degree.

Articulation Agreement between Southwestern Community College and Western Carolina University for transfer of credit from the A.A.S. Early Childhood degree at SCC into the Bachelors of Science in Birth-Kindergarten (teacher licensure) degree at WCU.

- A. SCC students will be admitted as candidates for the articulation program in Birth-Kindergarten upon the completion of the A.A.S. in Early Childhood.
- B. Students in the BK program, regardless of concentration, must earn and maintain a GPA of 2.5 before being admitted to the program. Students must apply during the semester they complete BK 250. Students may accumulate no more than 12 semester hours in the major before being admitted to the BK program.
- C. Students in the Professional Education concentration must be admitted to teacher education (See teacher education in the WCU Catalog) and are subject to all of the teacher education requirements including passing the Praxis PPST. BK 250 is the only course in the Professional Education Sequence that may be taken before admission to teacher education. The BK Professional Education Sequence includes BK 250, SPED 313, EDEL 313, CFS 468, BK, SPED, EDEL 483, BK, SPED, EDEL 496.
- D. The requirements for continuing in the program are: (1) a GPA of at least 2.5 on hours attempted; (2) behavior which adheres to the code of ethics of the profession; and (3) satisfactory participation in the required professional field experiences, which is prerequisite to internship. An evaluation of each field experience assignment will become a part of the student's professional record.
- E. SCC students can earn additional semester hours of transfer credit by completing general education and program requirement courses. Students who complete the 44 hour general education core of courses approved in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement in 1997 will have WCU liberal studies requirements waived. Courses used to complete the 44 hour core must be North Carolina community college system semester courses. All courses must be completed with a "C" or higher grade.
- F. To graduate from Western with a Birth-Kindergarten degree all students must complete a minimum of 32 semester hours of upper level Western course credit, including a minimum of 12 hours in the major field as described in the attached course equivalency outline.
- G. This agreement will run continually without need for renewal. Copies of this agreement will be distributed to the deans and department heads by February 1 of each year. Any updates to this agreement should be submitted by March 15. If curriculum changes occur in any of the courses identified in this agreement, parties from both institutions will review the changes and update the course equivalency outline.
- H. Either party upon written notice can terminate this agreement. If the agreement is terminated, SCC students who have matriculated at WCU can continue until completion of the baccalaureate degree if they are continuously enrolled at Western. Also, students who are enrolled at SCC at the time may continue under the terms of the agreement as long as they are continuously enrolled. If the student ceases enrollment for two regular academic semesters, he/she must re-enroll under the most recently adopted agreement.
