

**Articulation Agreement**  
**Southwestern Community College Outdoor Leadership and Western Carolina University**  
**Parks and Recreation Management concentration in Outdoor Leadership.**

This articulation agreement between Southwestern Community College and Western Carolina University allows graduates of SCC's Outdoor Leadership program to transfer credit towards a Bachelor of Science in Parks and Recreation Management with a concentration in Outdoor Leadership. A minimum of 32 semester hours of upper level course credit, including 12 semester hours in the major field, need to be completed at Western to earn the Parks and Recreation Management degree.

**Articulation Agreement between Southwestern Community College and Western Carolina University for transfer of credit from the A.A.S. Outdoor Leadership degree at SCC into the Bachelors of Science in Parks and Recreation Management degree at WCU.**

- A. Students will be admitted as candidates for the articulation program in Parks and Recreation Management upon the completion of the A.A.S. Outdoor Leadership degree.
- B. Students applying under this articulation agreement must meet the same admission standards as all other WCU students for entrance into the Parks and Recreation Management program. An undergraduate grade point average of 2.5 is required for admission to the program
- C. Students can earn additional semester hours of transfer credit by completing general education and program requirement courses. Students who complete the 44-hour general education core of courses approved in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement in 1997 will have WCU liberal studies requirements waived. Courses used to complete the 44-hour core must be North Carolina community college system semester courses. All courses must be completed with a "C" or higher grade.
- D. To graduate from Western with a Parks and Recreation Management degree all students must complete a minimum of 32 semester hours of upper level Western course credit, including a minimum of 12 hours in the major field as described in the attached course equivalency outline.
- E. This agreement will run continually without need for renewal. Copies of this agreement will be distributed to the deans and department heads by February 1 of each year. Any updates to this agreement should be submitted by March 15. If curriculum changes occur in any of the courses identified in this agreement, parties from both institutions will review the changes and update the course equivalency outline.
- F. Either party upon written notice can terminate this agreement. If the agreement is terminated, SCC students who have matriculated at WCU can continue until completion of the baccalaureate degree if they are continuously enrolled at Western. Also, students who are enrolled at SCC at the time may continue under the terms of the agreement as long as they are continuously enrolled. If the student ceases enrollment for two regular academic semesters, he/she must re-enroll under the most recently adopted agreement.
