TRAINING SESSION APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants who meet the established application requirements, and possess no disqualifying factor(s), may submit (via mail) their original & completed application packet (SEE: SCC-PSTC NPS-SLET ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS) accompanied by the training session Deposit (Supply & Material Fee) to:

DO NOT submit a Deposit (Supply & Material Fee) if you are uncertain about your ability to commit to the requested Training Session. Instead, request consideration for assignment to the Training Session's "Waiting List." Applicants who request assignment to a Training Session's "Waiting List" are required to complete the application process with supporting documentation, excluding the submission of the Training Session Deposit (Supply & Material Fee).

NOTE: Effective Fall 2012 (Class #89), the SCC-PSTC Training Session enrollment/assignment for SCC-PSTC NPS-SLET Training Sessions will be limited to twenty (20) Recruits, emphasizing our commitment to the quality of training provided to the Recruits assigned to a NPS-SLET training session. Historically, Training Sessions prior to Spring 2012 (Class #88) were limited to thirty (30) Recruits.

Indirectly, this also increases the competitiveness of the Application process for each Training Session and raises the quality of prospective employment candidates for the National Park Service (NPS) following their successful completion of training. Therefore, only serious and highly-motivated applicants should apply to the SCC-PSTC NPS-SLET program.
