The Career & College Promise (CCP) program allows public, private and homeschool students in the 11th and 12th grades to take college courses tuition-free. Courses are arranged into pathways to give students an opportunity to begin their college careers through earning certificates and/or college transfer credit.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A student may be in a College Transfer Pathway AND a Career Technical Certificate, or two Career Technical Certificates, but NOT two College Transfer Pathways.
- Courses may be taken in any order, except courses with required prerequisites and corequisites.
- When a student completes ALL categories in a pathway, he or she may take other classes required for the degree, diploma or certificate.
- No course substitutions are allowed.
- To maintain eligibility for continued enrollment, a student must: (1) continue to make progress toward high school graduation and (2) maintain a 2.0 GPA in college coursework.
- Students may only take courses designated as CCP by the state.

COLLEGE TRANSFER **REQUIREMENTS**

The College Transfer pathway will allow a student to BEGIN working on Universal General Education Transfer Core (UGETC) classes. Additional classes will be required to complete an associate degree.

REQUIREMENTS

- Junior or Senior in North Carolina Public, Private or Homeschool
- Complete SCC paper application for high school students.
- Submit an official high school transcript.
- Textbooks and other required materials must be purchased by the student (or high school).
- Student/parent will be responsible for transportation to/from seat-based classes.
- 2.8 unweighted high school GPA (current official transcript required)

• Demonstrate "college readiness" on an approved test or tests. Eligibility may be demonstrated by achieving the required scores on a single test or by combining test scores from any of the approved assessments
