- Booths will be offered in the indoors and outdoors. Indoors spaces are first come, first served. Power and rented tables are <u>not</u> available outdoors. Outdoor spaces are \$25, indoor spaces are \$55.
- <u>Deadline for applications is 5:00pm Oct. 9, 2023</u>. Payment MUST be enclosed with the application. The event is juried to ensure a variety of quality products. You will receive notification of your acceptance by Oct. 10, 2023. Payment will not be processed until notification of acceptance.
- Any remaining spaces will be available until Nov. 1.
- If you must cancel after acceptance, a refund will be supplied only if a replacement can be found for your space. No refunds after Nov. 1, 2023.
