Service Learning

With SCC Upward Bound, a college prep program, we helped direct traffic for four hours at the Frog Fair in Franklin, NC on November 5th. An unbelievable amount of people thought I was waving, but overall we were a huge help. The Frog Fair was put on by Friends of the Greenway (FROG) at Frog Quarters. FROG promotes education about the Little Tennessee River Greenway in Macon County. The greenway runs along the Little Tennessee River. The greenway is a great place to walk or jog, and

also for picnics. It is a fun place to explore.

On the 23rd of November, my church group and I went to the shoebox processing center in Atlanta, Georgia to pack boxes for Operation Christmas Child. My job was to fill cardboard boxes with shoe boxes. I also had to tape the cardboard boxes and put them on a conveyor belt. These shoeboxes went to South Sudan. We could not allow any food, money, dangerous items, or anything with a lot of camo. (If any-

thing were to be packed with a lot of camo, it would remind the kids of war.) I did this for four hours. When I left, there were about 40,000 boxes ready to be shipped.

I enjoyed doing these things because I felt that I helped good causes. Doing community service at the processing center for Operation Christmas Child felt so great to me. It didn't feel like work, it felt like I simply made children happy in South Sudan.

College Connection: SCC/College Transfer



• Did you know that one of the most cost effective ways to obtain your four-year degree is by starting at SCC?

Through an agreement with the University of North Carolina system, SCC students can earn up to 61 hours worth of credit that will transfer to any public university and many private colleges in the state. Completion of the <u>Associate in Arts</u>, <u>Associate in Fine Arts</u>, or <u>Associate in Science</u> degree program ensures students' transfer with junior status into most majors.

Career Exploration: Optician



- One of only two such programs in the state, Opticianry prepares you to adapt and fit corrective eyewear or ophthalmic devices as prescribed by the ophthalmologist or optometrist.
- Opticians are licensed health professionals who fit eyeglasses or contact lenses, using prescriptions written by ophthalmologists or optometrists. Eyewear is the term used for eyeglasses, contact lenses and low vision aids.
- Employment opportunities include working in offices of optometrists or ophthalmologists. Opticians also work in stores that sell eyeglasses, contact lenses, visual aids and other optical goods. These stores may be stand-alone businesses or parts of larger retail establishments, such as department stores. Some opticians choose to own their own business.
