#### **Hours & Schedules**

## "SCC Alert" App

Just in time for the first day of classes, we'll be launching the "SCC Alert" app. All SCC updates and information can be directly accessed using your phone or tablet. Every day before leaving home, we request that you take the "COVID-19 Self-assessment" in this app. If you receive a green light, you are welcome to proceed to our campus. Otherwise, please follow the instructions you receive.



#### Cleaning & Personal **Protective Equipment**

We've implemented cleaning protocols that meet or exceed CDC sanitization guidelines and are in accordance with NCDHHS and Jackson County Department of Public Health guidelines. Classrooms have been reconfigured to accommodate social distancing for face-to-face classes, and all employees and students will be supplied with Personal Protective Equipment at the beginning of - and throughout - the fall semester.



#### **Precautions**

Outside and inside every SCC building, signs clearly describe our requirements for employees, students and visitors:

- Social Distance
- Wear a mask indoors
- Wash your hands frequently
- Go/stay home if you have been tested or are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
- One person at a time in restrooms & elevators



## **Testing, Contact Tracing &** Quarantining

SCC has established a COVID-19 Response team, which has developed protocols in consultation with Jackson County Department of Public Health officials. If you begin experiencing symptoms after arriving on campus, we encourage you to get tested and quarantine. Every SCC building has a designated "Quarantine Room" set aside where you can wait, if need be, for a ride to take you home and/or a testing site.
