ACADEMY APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. 18 years old, with High School Diploma
- 2. Member in good standing with North Carolina volunteer fire department
- 3. Department issued personal protective equipment for class
- 4. An open-mind, good attitude, and will to push yourself
- 5. Supply fee \$500, used to cover textbooks, uniforms, and materials
